



Justification for the Deletion of the BS Degree in Trade & Technical Studies

Justification

The department of Instructional Systems, Leadership, Workforce Development is seeking the deletion of the BS in Trade & technical Studies. The reasons for this deletion are as follows:

The degree has only one student currently registered and he will be graduating at the end of spring 2008. This will leave the program with zero students enrolled.

Therefore, we would like to request that BS Trade & Technical Studies be removed from the course offerings of Mississippi State University.

Enrollment and the program's entry into the University catalog was suspended in the Fall of 2006 to allow for the students in the program to graduate.

Due to the small numbers of students that were enrolled in the program the impact of the deletion of the Trade & Technical Studies BS will not have any impact or affect on the resources of the department.
